Rotorua Boys' High School is the oldest High School in Rotorua and is committed to providing an excellent education for young men. The school enjoys national and international recognition for its academic excellence, sporting achievements and for the quality of its cultural endeavours. All students have the opportunity to develop to their full potential and to strive for excellence.

Location and Facilities

Rotorua Boys' High School is located close to the centre of Rotorua, which is New Zealand's leading tourist centre. The region is world famous for fishing in the lakes and streams, and for the geothermal activity which is a distinctive feature of the region.

The school is set in spacious and park-like grounds covering 11 hectares. Our state-of-the-art facilities include: the very latest in Workshop and Food Technology facilities, Performing Arts Theatre, various modern sporting facilities, Student Study Centre, Cafeteria and Lounge. Other facilities include: School Hall, Library, Specialist rooms for all subjects, Computer suites, Drama room, Music room, Horticulture complex, Gymnasium, Canteen and student carpark.

Academic Programme

The school encourages academic achievement at all levels and prepares students for study at universities, polytechnics and other tertiary institutions. It offers a full range of academic subjects, a number of specialist academies and operates career based programmes at senior levels.

Sporting Programme

Sports are well catered for with four rugby fields, soccer field, hockey field, cricket pitches and projectile sports hall, athletic track, tennis courts, basketball courts. The school also has an indoor heated swimming pool, two gymnasias including excellent weight training facilities and a climbing wall, a golf driving range and a projectile sports hall for indoor cricket. The school operates Rugby, Golf and multi-sport academies, supporting our national ranking in golf, rugby, badminton, cricket, waterpolo and basketball.

English Language Support

We have a well established ESOL Unit headed by a Dean of International Students who is very experienced in ESOL teaching and is qualified with BA English Language and Literature, and the Cambridge CELTA Certificate (Cambridge English Language Teaching Certificate). She is supported by ESOL teachers and teacher aides with CELTA qualifications.

On arrival each student is assessed and an individual English language programme is planned. Small group instruction is offered at Beginner, Elementary, Intermediate and Upper Intermediate levels, as is tuition for the IELTS examination. All International Students are expected to participate in New Zealand Certificate English examinations and New Zealand Speech Board examinations.

Student Welfare

An extensive guidance and counselling network is provided. In addition, a senior staff member has been appointed Dean of International Students and is responsible for the welfare and progress of our international students.

Accommodation

We will also organise homestay accommodation with a New Zealand family.

Fees
