The Hockey Academy is incorporated into the students in-school physical education time allowing them to develop within school hours.

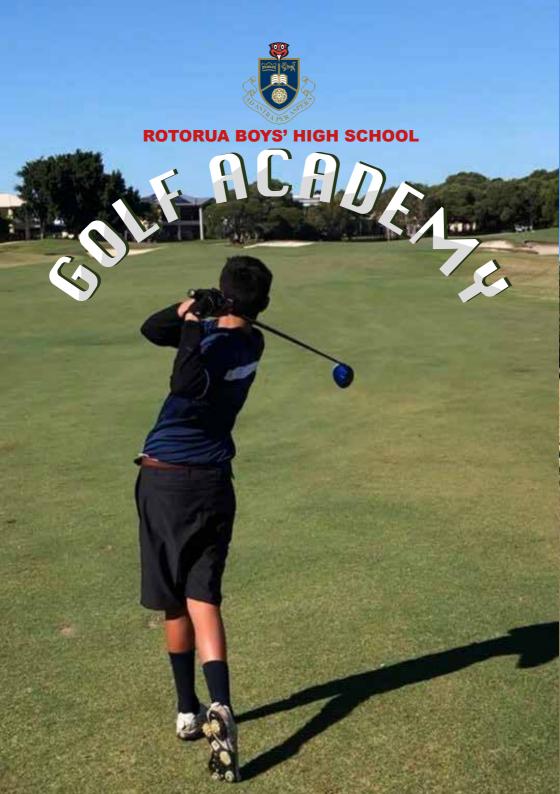
