This letter is being sent to advise that a staff member of our school has received advice today that he is a confirmed case of COVID-19. The teacher concerned was at school on Tuesday 15 February 2022, but has not attended on other days this week.

Only those who have received a letter advising they are a close contact should not come to school.

Those that have not received a letter advising you are a close contact should still come to school.

What you need to do

- You and your whānau should watch for symptoms
- If any develop, get tested immediately
- Then, stay at home until you receive the result
- If your whānau hasn't been vaccinated, please do so as soon as possible. You can book on-line at bookmyvaccine.nz or by calling 0800 28 29 26. It's free.

What we're doing

- Rotorua Boys' High School will stay open
- We have appropriate public health measures and cleaning procedures in place

Symptoms of COVID-19

- A new or worsening cough
- Sneezing and runny nose
- A fever
- Temporary loss of smell or altered sense of taste
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath

Less common symptoms include diarrhoea, headache, muscle aches, nausea, vomiting, malaise, chest pain, abdominal pain, joint pain, or confusion/irritability.
